**Quick Guide to
EXPORTING, SHARING AND POSTING YOUR DIGITAL STORY**

This quick guide should be used in conjunction with the educast *Exporting, Sharing and Posting Your Digital Story*. These materials illustrate the exporting process and offer suggestions for publishing and distributing your digital story. Be sure to review previous educasts for more details on uploading to specific online sites.

Step 1: Options for Exporting Your Story from MovieMaker

- 1a) Expand Movie Tasks menu and choose "3. Finish Movie"
- 1b) Click "Save to my computer"
- 1c) Enter title of your digital story (if different from default)
- 1d) Browse to place on computer to save your digital story file (if different from default)
- 1e) Click "Next" at bottom of wizard
- 1f) Review movie settings information
- 1g) Click "Next" at bottom of wizard
- 1h) Click "Finish" when process is complete
- 1i) Select other options for saving as appropriate

Step 2: Reviewing the Exported Piece

- 2a) View and listen to digital story

Step 3: Sharing Your Story

- 3a) Upload your story to "*Share Your Story*" at pbs.org/nationalparks/share-your-story/

- 3b) Upload your story to YouTube, Vimeo or Teacher's Tube
- 3c) Embed your story in a Google Map
(see *Making a Collective Map Using Google Maps* educast and/or quick guide for more information)
- 3d) Upload and geo-tag images in Flickr (see *Geo-Tagging Your Photos Using Flickr* educast and/or quick guide for more information)
- 3e) Embed your story in your website
