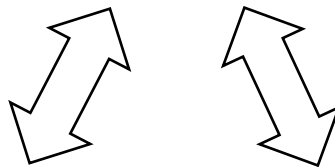


Analyzing Primary Sources

Directions: Use the following graphic organizer to organize your thoughts as you study a primary source.

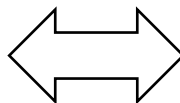
