Super YOU Final Assessment

Watch the *Three Little Pigs SUPER WHY* episode with your child/children. Now, after the week's activities, ask your child the same questions you did prior to these days of activities and see how they have progressed:

- Do you know the story of *The Three Little Pigs*?
- What is it about?
- Alpha Pig Literacy Skills from episode:
 - Ask your child to point to the letters W-O-L-F on the Alpha Pig Activity Sheet.
- Wonder Red Literacy Skills from episode:
 - Ask your child to read the word WALL on the Wonder Red Activity Sheet.
 - Ask your child to read the word FALL on the Wonder Red Activity Sheet.
 - Ask your child to read the word BALL on the Wonder Red Activity Sheet.
- Princess Presto Literacy Skills from episode:
 - Ask your child, *How do you spell "big"?*
 - Ask your child, *How do you spell "pig"?*
- Super Why Literacy Skills from episode
 - Show your child the Activity sheet showing the three Super Why Words: small, red, good.
 - Now show your child the Activity sheet showing the Super Why sentence: There once was a big bad wolf.
 - Ask your child, *What is the opposite of "big"?*
 - *What is the opposite of "bad"?*
 - Point to the three words. *Which word is the word "good"?*
