Pea

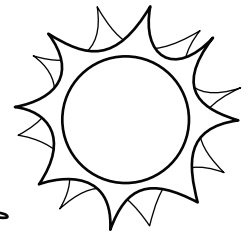
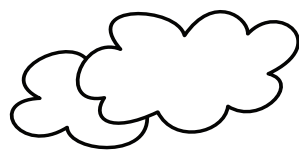
