



Dress Like Sid!

Help your child pretend to be their favorite scientist with this easy costume you can make at home!

Materials (The Stuff We Need)

- Red hoodie
- Blue pants
- Red sneakers
- Lavender yarn (or purple colored hair spray or wig)
- Magnifying glass or microphone

Procedure (What to Do)

1. Start by dressing in the red hoodie, blue pants and red sneakers.
2. If hair spray or a colored wig is too much for your little scientist, try creating Sid's hair by using some thick lavender-colored yarn.
3. Cut the yarn in long lengths that can reach ear-to-ear over your child's head. Cut enough pieces to cover your child's head. Use a shorter piece of yarn to tie all the pieces together in the middle.
4. Fasten your Sid "wig" to your child's head using hair clips or bobby pins and trim the yarn "bangs" as needed to your child can see.
5. For a final touch, your child can carry a magnifying glass or microphone.
