



Sid's Backyard Campout Scavenger Hunt!



Get a journal from the grown-up in charge, grab your backpacks and let's go on an exciting Backyard Scavenger Hunt!

1. Your backyard might be a habitat for tiny living creatures!

See if you can find 3 different kinds of insects and draw a picture of them in your journal (examples: ants, ladybugs, mosquitoes, beetles, lightning bugs).

2. Can you make a hypothesis (an idea you can test) about what animals you might see in your backyard?

Write down the names of at least 3 animals you hope to see during your campout (examples: squirrels, rabbits, lizards, birds, raccoons). Use your observation skills and if you spot an animal, record it in your journal.

3. Do you see any light?

Is the sun shining or is the moon glowing? Is there enough light to make a shadow? Make a list in your journal of all the sources of light.

4. Are there any plants in your backyard?

Find your favorite leaf or flower and draw it in your journal.

Remember not to pick it!
